Starting June 10th, they will take place on Thursday nights in the summer and Saturday nights in September and October. Be sure to note times since they will change with the seasons. The new schedule means we are losing some dates but will still be offering the variety of entertainment you have come to love in the series.
- 2. Bonfires on the Beach:** There is nothing better than a bonfire on a chilly night, right? So, bonfires are being moved to Friday nights in October from 8 – 10 pm.
- 3. Movies on the Beach/Bandstand:** These will stay the same – Mondays on the beach off Garfield June 7th through August 23rd and Fridays on the Bandstand September 3rd, 17th, and 24th at dusk.
